Be a part of feis history! Join us for the 27th annual Feis in the Desert (FITD), and the first—ever Dancing in the Dust Feis (DITD). Both events will be held in the charming town of Carefree, AZ, just north of Scottsdale, over the Martin Luther King holiday weekend, January 14th – 15th, at the [Carefree Resort and Conference Center](#). The property was recently remodeled and offers a pool, spa, fitness center, free parking and more. We have an amazing room rate of \$139 per night (includes resort fee) for a limited block of rooms – don't hesitate, book this rate before they are gone! The rate is available 3 days before/after should you wish to arrive early and stay late to enjoy the warm Arizona sunshine! Call or go online and ask for Damhsa – feis rate.

Our weekend of events begins with Grade Exams starting Friday evening and running through the weekend. Saturday night, everyone is invited to join us for a **Traditional Irish Ceile**, complete with Irish music, cash bar and loads of fun. Dinner will be available for purchase and can be prepaid at a special rate when registering on Feisworx. Sunday will be the inaugural DITD Feis and both events will feature a recall list for champ-level dancers, 50% placement at all levels, fun specials and unique trophies crafted by local artisans.

When not participating in our scheduled activities, enjoy golf, shopping in the "old west", and playing tourist in the towns of Carefree and Cave Creek. A free hotel shuttle is available between the hotel and town.

2. All competition times are approximate. **Please be ready to dance one hour before your scheduled time.** The Feis Committee will call a missing entrant three times maximum. Competitors who fail to appear when called will forfeit their right to participate in that particular competition. We will not delay a competition for any reason.
3. Competitions will be combined if the numbers warrant that decision.
4. Awards will be posted in a timely manner.
5. We wish to remind you Rule 29: In consideration of safety and in fairness to dancer performing at a Feis, photography of any kind which has the capacity of capturing a dancer's image while in motion is strictly forbidden.
6. When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.
7.
